Typical Uses May be used on suitably prepared:

Exterior thin film plaster

Solid plasterConcrete block

Physical Properties Binder type 100% acrylic

Solvent Water

Colour White and tinted colours
Finish Satin – 20% gloss
Dry time 40 minutes at 20°C
Recoat time 4 hours at 20°C

Number of coats 2 or 3 (see application details below)

Theoretical coverage 6-8m² per litre

Rec. film thickness 120-150 microns per coat, WFT

Thinning and clean up Water

Preparation Ensure surfaces are free from loose and flaking paint. Wash surfaces with a suitable exterior cleaner prior

to painting to remove dirt, oils, grease and other contaminants. Where there has been mould, treat the area

with a moss and mould remover.

Application Aalto Ultra Premium Exterior Flexibuild can be applied by synthetic brush, roller, or spray.

Airless spray - a 523 tip or larger is recommended due to the fibres in the paint, and a coarse filter should

be used.

Exterior plaster - previously painted, fine hairline cracks

1. Apply 2 coats of Aalto Ultra Premium Exterior Flexibuild, allowing 4 hours between coats

Exterior plaster - previously painted, large hairline cracks

1. Fill any cracks larger than 2mm with a suitable exterior paintable filler

2. Apply 1 coat of a flexible membrane coating at a spread rate of 2m² per litre

3. Apply 2 coats of Aalto Premium Exterior Flexibuild, allowing 4 hours between coats

Exterior plaster - new and unpainted

1. Apply 1 coat of a flexible membrane coating at a spread rate of 2m² per litre

2. Apply 2 coats of Aalto Ultra Premium Exterior Flexibuild, allowing 4 hours between coats

Fibre cement, concrete slab, concrete brick

1. Apply 2 coats of Aalto Ultra Premium Exterior Flexibuild, allowing 4 hours between coats



Maintenance

Maintain your exterior paint surface by washing it every 12 months (after each winter is a great time), with a suitable exterior cleaner to remove dirt deposits. We do not recommend the use of bleach as this can affect the appearance of the colour over time. Dirt, salt, and bird deposits left on the paint surface will encourage the growth of mould, and affect the paints performance.

Performance and Limitations

Performance

- Excellent durability and gloss retention
- Excellent flexibility
- Resists dirt pick-up

Limitations

- Large hairline cracks must be repaired with a suitable exterior flexible and paintable filler
- Satin finish may be overcoated with Aalto Ultra Premium Exterior Gloss or Low Sheen if a different sheen level is required
- Should not be applied if temperatures are below 5°C or when it is liable to drop below 5°C during the drying period

Health Effects

When dry, recycle steel containers via steel can recycling programs. Disposal of empty paint containers via domestic recycling programs may vary between local authorities.
