Thinning and clean up Water (in hot conditions can be thinned up to 5% with hot weather thinners)

Preparation Ensure surfaces are free from loose and flaking paint. Wash surfaces with a suitable cleaner such as sugar

soap prior to painting to remove dirt, oils, grease and other contaminants. Where there has been mould,

treat the area with a moss and mould remover.

Old enamels will require fine sanding to a uniform dull finish.

Application Aalto Ultra Premium Waterbased Enamel Low Sheen can be applied by synthetic brush, roller, or spray.

Airless spray – a 415 or 515 tip is recommended.

Rolling - a microfibre 6mm nap roller sleeve is recommended.

Because of the quick drying nature of Aalto Ultra Premium Waterbased Enamel Low Sheen, in hot conditions

it may be necessary to thin up to 5% with hot weather thinners.

When rolling walls that are highlighted by natural lighting from large windows, you will need to 'lay off' with the roller in one direction after applying the paint. This should be done in one continuous operation from one end of the wall to the other without stopping. For large areas, two applicators may be required – one to lay on the paint, and one to 'lov off'.

#### Plasterboard, wallboard, Gib® board

- 1. Apply 1 coat of Aalto Interior Sealer Undercoat
- 2. Lightly sand and dust off
- Apply 2 coats of Aalto Ultra Premium Waterbased Enamel Low Sheen, allowing 2-4 hours between coats

#### Timber, particle board, customwood

- 1. Apply 1 coat of Aalto 3 in 1 Undercoat
- Apply 2 coats of Aalto Ultra Premium Waterbased Enamel Low Sheen, allowing 2-4 hours between coats

#### Previously painted surfaces

- 1. Remove any flaking paint off the surface and sand to a smooth finish
- 2. If painting over old oil based enamels, wash down with sugar soap and sand lightly to a dull finish
- 3. Prime any areas of bare timber with Aalto 3 in 1 Undercoat
- Apply 2 coats of Aalto Ultra Premium Waterbased Enamel Low Sheen, allowing 2-4 hours between coats

#### Maintenance

Maintain your interior paint finish by cleaning with a damp cloth and neutral detergent (such as diluted sugar soap). Cleaners that contain solvents may affect the surface appearance and the paints longevity. Dry dust corners frequently to avoid dust and dirt build up.

#### Performance and Limitations

#### Performance

- Ultimate hardwearing wall finish
- Can be used in place of traditional oil based enamels
- Non-yellowing
- Easy application properties with excellent flow and levelling
- Excellent durability in high service areas

### Limitations

- Should not be applied if temperatures are below 10°C or when it is liable to drop below 10°C during the drying period
- Dry time may be impeded if the relative humidity is high
- Ensure that the correct primer and/or sealer is used
- When painting doors and trim, Aalto Ultra Premium Waterbased Enamel in a satin finish or higher is recommended
- After application, allow 12-48 hours before the area becomes fully serviceable, with full hardness developing after 1-3 weeks

Spills and Disposal

Check with your local council regarding the disposal of empty paint containers. Empty paint containers should be left open in a well-ventilated area to dry out. When dry, recycle steel containers via steel can recycling programs. Disposal of empty paint containers via domestic recycling programs may vary between local authorities.
